



HOW TO TAKE A FEC SAMPLE

For FEC's please 2/3 fill the pot with fresh droppings, ideally a little from several areas in the droppings. Please avoid shavings contamination. Ideally, the pot should be brought straight to us. Still, it can be kept in the fridge overnight if necessary (the longer the sample is left before being read, the more eggs will have hatched, and thus not be counted, giving an inaccurate reading).

You **MUST** bring in the sample in the labelled pots provided as they are labelled correctly; otherwise, a fee will be charged for testing.

Samples can be brought to:

- » Main Hook Norton Surgery, 8 am - 3 pm, Monday to Thursday. Please contact us in advance if bringing in more than five samples.
- » Deddington, Charlbury & Moreton branches, 8 am - 11 am, Monday to Thursday.
